



months. Beautiful summer days fill up quickly with music festivals, fairs, the Mountain Man Rendezvous, rodeos, ropings and barbecues.

Many have left their mark on this unique part of the West. Artifacts of Native Americans hunting and living in this area date back 10,000 years and can be found at local museums in both Pinedale and Big Piney. Next to arrive



were intrepid explorers, bold men who traveled into the valley around 1811 with the American Fur Company. In their footsteps followed the mountain men such as Jim Bridger and William Sublette, who established this as a site for the famous Fur Trade Rendezvous. The Oregon Trail emigrants also passed through the county. Ranchers, cowboys, outlaws, Pony Express riders...all would follow and help develop Sublette County's fascinating cultural heritage.



#### The Most Scenic Country in the West

Bring your binoculars and a camera to Sublette County-this is some of the most scenic country in the West. Set at 7000' in elevation, you'll find rivers, lakes, wildlife and towering mountains. Three rugged mountain ranges – the Wind River, Gros Ventre, and Wyoming ranges surround our high desert on three sides.

One of Sublette County's most scenic and popular destinations accessible by car is the Green River Lakes. Not only is the journey to



Green River Lakes scenic and rich in history, but the end point rewards the traveler with the stunning,





much-photographed view of Squaretop Mountain looming over the blue-green lakes, with stands of aspen and pine blanketing the hillsides.

Sublette County's spectacular Bridger Wilderness area contains more than 1.2 million acres of designated wilderness, offering primitive backcountry experiences. Along with the Gros Ventre Wilderness, these regions provide pristine, unspoiled terrain where man is but a visitor. Indeed, deer and antelope outnumber people ten-fold in this high mountain valley, so it's easy to

enjoy wildlife year around in their natural habitat. Sublette County is home to elk, mule deer, antelope, wolves, moose, grizzly and black bear, big horn sheep, and a wide variety of fish.

# **Oregon Trail**

In the 1840's through 1850's, with the fur trade era over, emigrants began passing through the area on their way to Oregon and California. The Lander Cut-Off, a short cut of the Oregon Trail established in 1859, passes through the county and parts of the trail are still visible today and can be followed. "Buckskin Crossing", on Big Sandy Creek was a ford of the Lander Cut-off of the Oregon Trail. It was an important resting and watering campsite that was heavily used by the emigrants. Of their hundreds of wagon and thousands of mules, cattle and horses, only a few marked graves remain. This trail was the mail route from the east to the west side of the Wind River Mountains in the early 1900's.



#### Rendezvous Grounds

In the early 1820s and 1830s, western Wyoming was the heart of "mountain man" country. Hardy fur traders and trappers, such as Jim Bridger and William Sublette, came here to make a living from the beaver that inhabited the area streams. The Green River Valley was the site for most of the fur trade Rendezvous which were held in the spring to refurnish the mountain men with supplies and buy the pelts. The annual Rendezvous, which was held in a different location each year, brought many mountain men and natives together for fun and trade. This valley and the rendezvous were such a central part of the fur trade era that phrase "Meet me on the Green" was known by all.

#### The Pony Express

Although very shortlived, the Pony Express was an exciting aspect of the early area history. For eighteen months, starting in April 1860, Pony Express riders carried the mail some 2,000 miles in ten days. Each rode over 100 miles a day, changing horses every 10-15 miles. They connected California and Oregon to the rest of the United States. The completion of the transcontinental telegraph in October 1861, and instant communication, signaled the end of the Pony Express.
